




___ Between The Sky & The Sea




Designed by the Lebanese designer Mr. Richard Abi Saab is internationally renowned as one of contemporary interior architect and designer most inventive leaders. Situated on a gently weatherworn stone patio with classic architectural accents. Simultaneously evoking Lebanese glamour and contemporary modernism, the structure consists of a 274-sqm main floor with a lower level, and 2,500 sqm of surrounding serpentine like terraces connected with a bridge that seats 200 person and nestled right at the edge of the water, high above the beach overlooking the Mediterranean Sea. Through it's natural given situation the property has access to a private beach where wooden shelters provide shade.













Mr. Abi Saab developed the holistic design treatment for Blue, by placing an emphasis on essential and the the celebration of traditional craftsmanship that fosters an environment of effortless ease. He infused the site with traditional materials from the city, curating every detail from tableware to furniture, devoutly following classic construction techniques to create an environment that blends into the earthy tones of the land.
